Dr. Ruth Imrie, medical director of Cleveland Clinic Solon, has been a Clinic staff member since 1978. Her special interests include adolescent medicine, behavioral-developmental issues, school difficulties and dermatology. A graduate of Belfast's Queen's University, she has had postgraduate studies at hospitals there and specialty training at Toronto's Hospital for Sick Children. She is a fellow of both the Royal College of Physicians of London and the Society

of Adolescent Medicine. Dr. Imrie's extensive teaching experience has included appointments not only at the Cleveland Clinic but at Pennsylvania State and Case Western Reserve universities.
