William T. Monroe for many years has contributed his legal skills to his civic and church communities. Both have benefited, too, from his enthusiasm for his Irish heritage. The son of Irish immigrants. Monroe and his wife Pat (another "narrowback") have made nine trips to Ireland to visit relatives.

A partner in the law firm Monroe and Zucco, he is a graduate of St. Ignatius High School, John Carroll University following a two-year stint in the U.S Navy, and Cleveland Marshall College of Law. With his practice of law nearing 50 years, his professional memberships include the American, Ohio, Cleveland, Cuyahoga and Lake County Bar Associations. He has a history of leadership in several of these. He also has been an Ohio State Board of Education member, City of Euclid law director and magistrate.

Monroe's volunteer activities have been, among others, with the Hospice of the Western Reserve, where he prepared wills, powers of attorneys, etc. for terminally ill patients. He has seen 35 years of donated legal counsel to the Cleveland Catholic Diocese Society for the Propagation of the Faith as well as advocacy for its mission work in El Salvador.
